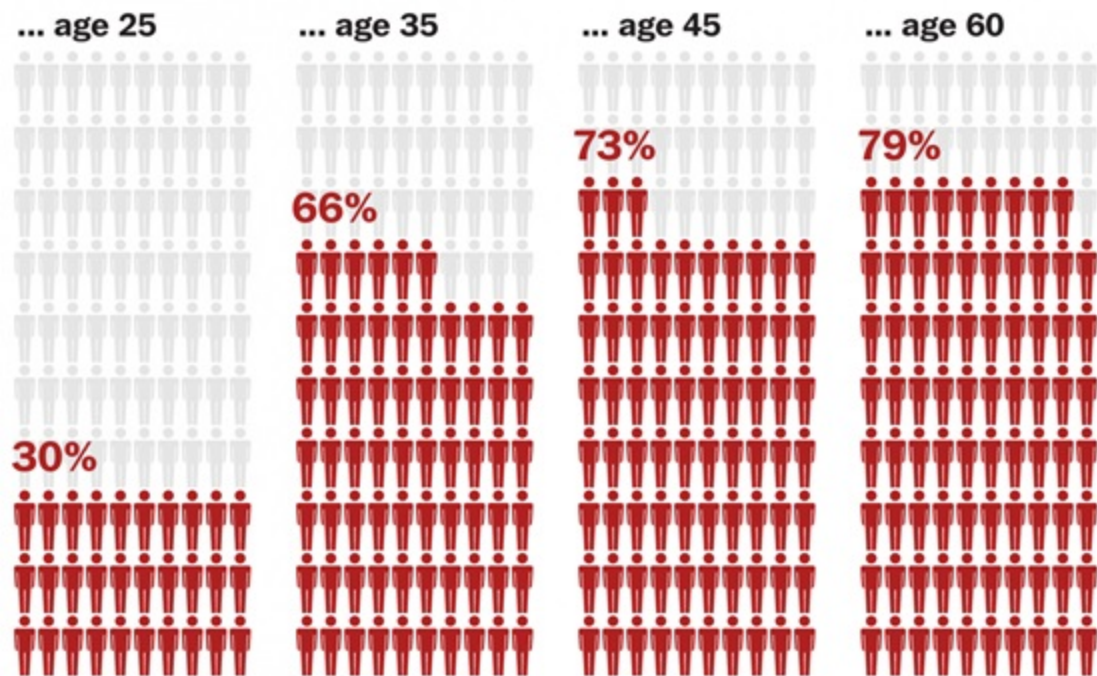


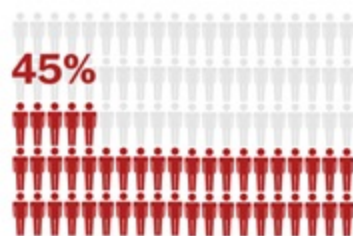
Economic hardship: surprisingly common

% of Americans who have experienced economic hardship at some point in their lives, by the time they reach...

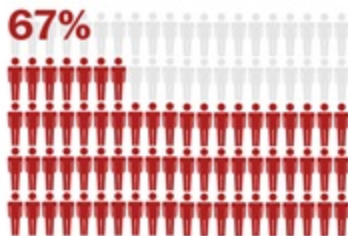


These people have received public assistance, been unemployed, or lived at least a year below 150% of the poverty line. The likelihood of experiencing each of those situations by age 60:
