Training includes in-depth presentations from the Bridges Out of Poverty and Applying Bridges Concepts seminars, so that you will be prepared to train others in your organization on Bridges Out of Poverty constructs and strategies. You will also receive comprehensive research and training materials. Learn how to tailor the Bridges approach to address the client-specific needs of your organization.
