- Housing Repair: providing emergency repairs to homes of families below the poverty line
- Community Service Block Grant: providing emergency interventions to prevent homelessness

- Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Program: helping families pay energy bills and increase their home's energy efficiency
- Youth Leadership: helping at-risk students increase self-sufficiency (academically, behaviorally, and socially)
- Homeless Services: Transitional Housing Program for homeless families and single adults
- CIRCLES: a national organization for mentoring and networking, SHARE is proudly the first in South Carolina

Pamela holds a dual Bachelor's degree from Furman University majoring in Accounting and Business Administration. Pamela is actively involved in the community as well. She serves as a member of the Board of Directors of Friends of Richland Cemetery and the Rotary Club of Greenville. She is a member of Mount Emmanuel Missionary Baptist Church where she is a dedicated servant as a Trustee, Financial Secretary and assist with the Missionary Ministry.
