Overview

WeTopeka Essentials Delivery, a new temporary service aimed at providing resource relief to those adversely affected by the COVID-19 pandemic in the Topeka-Shawnee County area. We are a volunteer-driven delivery service which delivers groceries and essential items straight to their doorstep of people and families in need, at no additional cost.

Here at WeTopeka Essentials Delivery, we know that sometimes all it takes to change the world is a little support. Built as a direct response to the COVID pandemic, we aim to make sure that all those who need essentials at their home during the crisis are able to do so, without putting themselves at risk or being burdened by excess costs.

Our founding team specializes in safe and effective volunteer management and providing resources for at-risk/low-income populations, and are prepared to help the Topeka community through these confusing times. **Community Action, Inc.** packages groceries and other items for delivery, i.e. diapers, personal care products, pet food, etc.

Food Items are provided through [Harvesters](#), a member of Feeding America's nationwide network of food banks. Weekly phone calls occur for planning and to review efforts to-date. Community Action, Inc. follows up with families served to determine additional needs for assistance.

Volunteer Drivers

Thirteen volunteer drivers signed up and 50 families were served during WeTopeka's first week of operation. This type of involvement helps people have a safe way to get out of their home during the pandemic while making a difference for others!
